



Service Contingency Plan Corona Virus 2021 (7/28/2021)

Purpose: To have a defined plan of action as the Corona Virus spread declines and COVID-19 mandates and safety recommendations are changed.

Objective: To protect the health and welfare of members and staff of the club and the fiscal welfare of the club.

Plan: Follow guidance based on the Center for Disease Control, Central District Health, State of Idaho rebound plan, Boise City, and USTA guidance for Tennis facilities, club management will track ongoing changes and take the following actions. We are doing everything we can when it comes to precautionary measures. Note: This plan and will be adjusted and modified as appropriate and circumstances dictate

Overall Safety Precautions:

- Follow CDC, State of Idaho, City of Boise, Central District Health, and USTA Guidelines.
- ADA county is classified as a substantial transmission area and CDC recommends fully vaccinated people wear masks in public indoor settings to help prevent the spread of the delta variant and to protect others.
- CDC recommends indoor masks usage for all as COVID variants have been documented to spread by vaccinated people.
- CDC recommendations do not include outdoor courts, decks, and pool areas
- Masks are **strongly-recommended** for everyone (vaccinated and not vaccinated) in the Clubhouse and other indoor gathering areas to help protect the health and safety of others. With the following exceptions
 - While on the courts playing tennis
 - While in the gym working out
 - While participating in fitness classes
 - While eating and drinking in the snack bar
- Staff shall wear masks while indoors in public areas.
- BRSC will continue to offer other services as-is.

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
