



Singles Ladder Format/Rules

Ladder starts: May 2021.

Scoring: 8 game pro set, you play a 10-point tiebreaker at 7-7.

Challenging: Players may challenge up to 3 places above them.

Match set up: Matches are set up by calling, texting, or emailing the person you want to challenge. Please use Club Automation or the directory on our website for contact information of players. Both players will pay for court time if it is needed.

Match Results: If you challenge a player 3 places above you and you beat that player you simply switch positions with that player. For Example-If position 8 challenges position 5 and beats them player 8 would move to position 5 and player 5 would move to position 8.

Challenging Rule: After challenging a player and completing the match, you may not challenge that same player for at least 3 weeks. If after 3 contact attempts the player does not respond please contact the ladder supervisor for further instructions.

Tennis Balls: Both players bring a can of balls to the match. One can is opened to play the match. Which ever player wins the match receives the new can of unopened tennis balls.

Late Entries: Players that want to join the ladder after it has started will be placed accordingly by the ladder supervisor.
