Treasurer's Report Steve Craig

July 2024

- Assets: \$262,408, including \$183878 cash (\$16,622 restricted), \$77934 Merrill Lynch.
- Liabilities: \$1,922, credit card (Querbes primarily and will be reimbursed by city).
- Total income: \$36,191, includes \$8,760 league, \$1,000 (BLT/KK Donation), \$15,689 Querbes (to reimburse for expenses paid and management of facility), \$327 Love Twice, NJTL 10,000, \$327 interest income.
- Total expenses: \$14,675, including \$4,779 QTC (to be reimbursed) and \$7,000 Scholarships expense to date.

 - Last year USTA had an extraordinary year, however, will probably not receive the same financial support as last year as the USTA getting ready to spend \$750mill on Arthur Ash Stadium which will use a lot of what was allocated this past year

- US OPEN ticket issues –USTA understands that 3rd parties buying all the US Open tickets and then selling at a marked-up price. USTA is trying to put stops in place to stop the ticket prices from skyrocketing.
 - Jay Boyd: suggested idea if you're a national volunteer, put something out to make tickets available.
 - Trying to figure out how normal volunteers to get a \$90 pass like in the past
- Louisiana hosted the Southern Conference in New Orleans Event went very well with the LTA party held in a New Orleans home in uptown on Friday and Saturday night, Southern held a party at the World War 2 Museum
- Grady: The president of Southern wants them to do a study to show how many volunteer hours there are and put a value on that. They're aware and trying to fix it.
